

Workshop in Emergency & Critical Care Ultrasound





Friday 17th May 2024

This workshop is aimed at practitioners in all acute specialties with limited or no experience in Emergency Point-of-care Ultrasound (PoCUS). It will comprise a balanced mix of lectures and practical sessions, and is recognised by the Royal College of Emergency Medicine as appropriate for curricular competencies. Previous courses have been approved for 5 points RCoA/RCEM CPD credit.

Faculty have extensive experience in the use and teaching of Emergency PoCUS and use it routinely in their specialties of Emergency Medicine and Critical Care.

Topics covered will include eFAST; AAA detection; Vascular Access; ECHO in life support, and pleural scanning.

The key aim of the day is to provide an intensive day of supervised/mentored scanning of healthy volunteers to rapidly learn and improve your ability to achieve quality imaging. Places will be limited to 20 to maximise hands-on experience, and places will be allocated mainly from the existing waiting list.
